OTA TO OT WEEKEND TRACK

Information Sheet

The academic year runs from July 1- June 30th.

SHTM orientation for the incoming class 2013 will be held on Monday, June 28th and the orientation for the OT program-weekend track will be Saturday, July 10, 2010. Attendance is required at both orientations.

Classes start July 10. Summer classes are every weekend in July & August. You will be taking Functional Anatomy which is a 5 credit course and Computer Literacy for 1 credit

Classes are held year round. No classes will be held on holiday weekends.

The schedule will vary due to the credit load. Some semesters the course work will be every other weekend. At other times it may be 2-3 weekends in class and then one weekend off.

Classes are held Saturdays & Sundays from 8 am – 6pm. There is a one hour break from 12:30-1:30 pm.

It is necessary for you to have access to a working computer. Some of your courses utilize Blackboard, which is an online teaching tool. Information such as lecture notes, syllabi, assignments, online links, etc are posted on Blackboard. It is the student's responsibility to monitor both Blackboard and e-mail on a regular basis.

Fieldwork Level II must be completed on a full time basis. You will need to be available forty hours per week for 12 weeks from May to July **and** from September to December of your graduate year [2012]

- Complete and submit application online
- Complete top section of reference reports (two from OTA and one from OT) and mail reference persons with envelope addressed to Office of Student Services (can also be sent online if accurate reference email addresses are known.)
- Request official transcript from all schools attended and send to Office of Student Services
- Request WES evaluation if attended school outside of the United States
- Undergraduate application fee
- Proof of OTA license
- Proof of one year employment as an OTA, letter on letterhead from your employer
- Proof of CPR certification
- Proof of First Aid certification
