Parking: You may park your car in the Stony Brook University Hospital garage off East Loop Road. The current cost is \$2.00/hour or \$10.00 per day. Monthly evening parking passes for the Health Sciences Center garage can be purchased by SHTM graduate students for \$11.37/month (access after 3 p.m. and weekend only) plus tax. Information on how to obtain a monthly parking card will be available during orientation. A permit is required to park on campus. Please register for your Stony Brook University parking permit through the web address (www.parking.sunysb.edu). When applying for your parking permit, please indicate that you would like your permit mailed to you. If you will be parking in the HSC garage only, you do not need to register for a Stony Brook University parking permit.

Registration: One of the most important events to be discussed at Orientation on June 23, 2009, is registration/enrollment for the fall 2009 semester. All details and instructions will be provided by your program advisor and you will be given directions to access the SOLAR system for on-line registration.
